Over **80%** of all cases of colorectal cancer can be prevented with recommended screening. Despite its high incidence, colorectal cancer is one of the most detectable, and if found early enough, most treatable forms of cancer.

Colon Cancer - is the **second** leading cause of **cancer death in men and women combined in the United States** and the **third** most commonly diagnosed cancer. The American Cancer Society estimates 96,930 new cases of colon cancer will be diagnosed in 2014 and is expected to cause around 50,310 deaths.

Risk Factors:

Colorectal polyps
Family history of colorectal cancer
Genetic alterations
Personal history of inflammatory bowel disease

Early Detection is the Key - Regular Screenings:

- Can detect cancers at an early stage where the cancer is most curable & preventable
- May detect pre-cancerous polyps. Removal of these polyps in early stages may prevent cancer from developing
